








EDUCATION RATES IN SUNSET PARK (2005–12)







FAMILIES EARNING BELOW 200% OF FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL (2012)





PERCENT OF HOUSEHOLDS LIVING IN POVERTY (2012)





## Figure 6 FAMILY INCOME AND RENT (2005–12)




Median income for families with children


