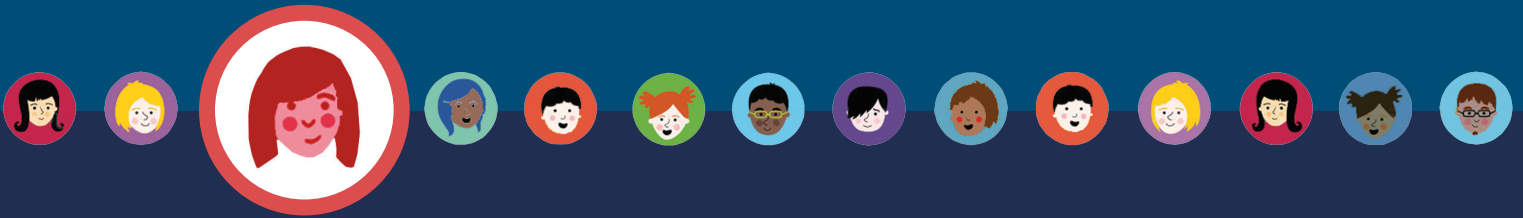
How many homeless children are there in New York City?
