Color in the number 2's to find Penelope. Color in the number 5's to find Pedro.



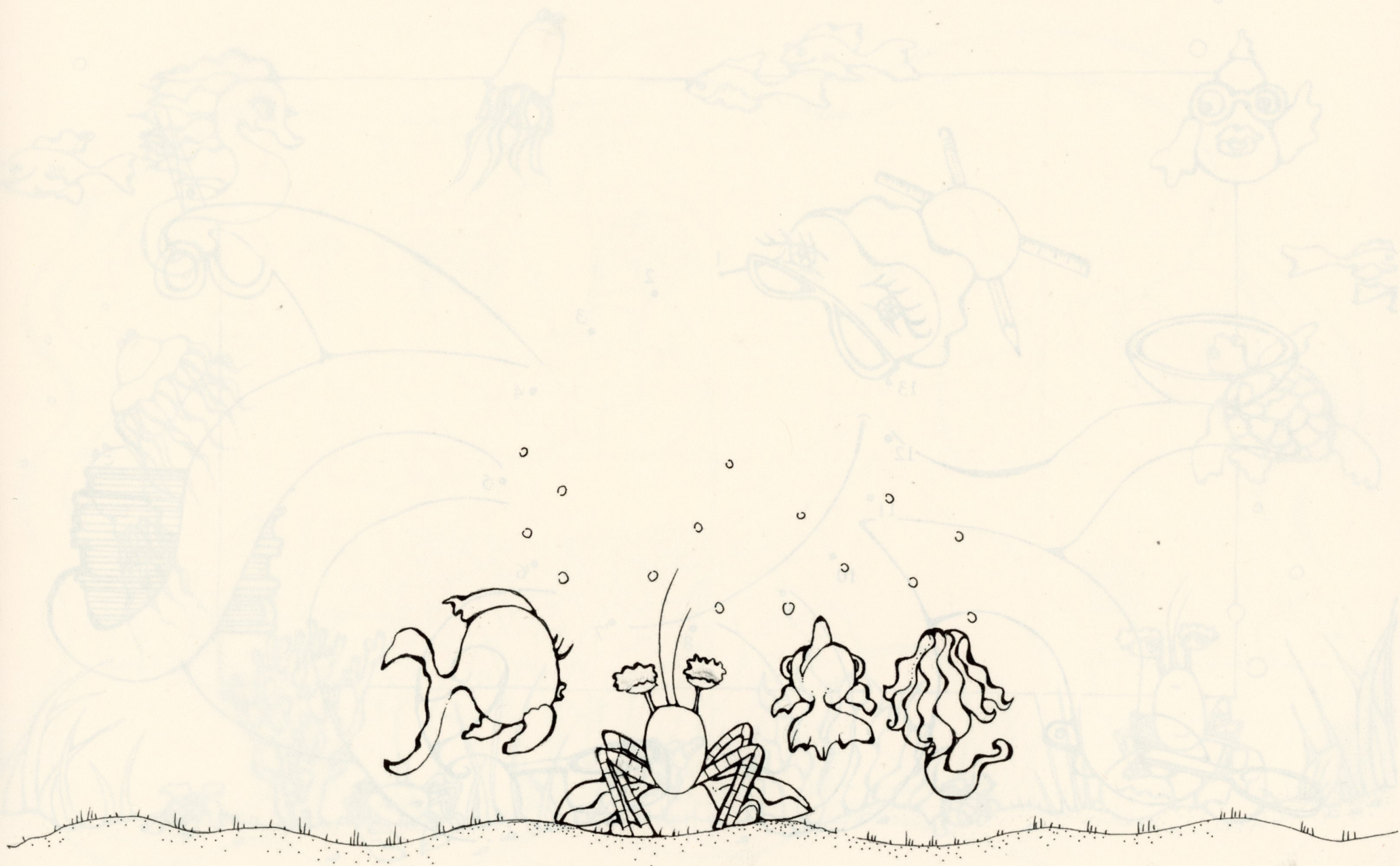
Help Herman, Serena, Pedro, and Penelope find their way to Shelter Cove by following the maze.



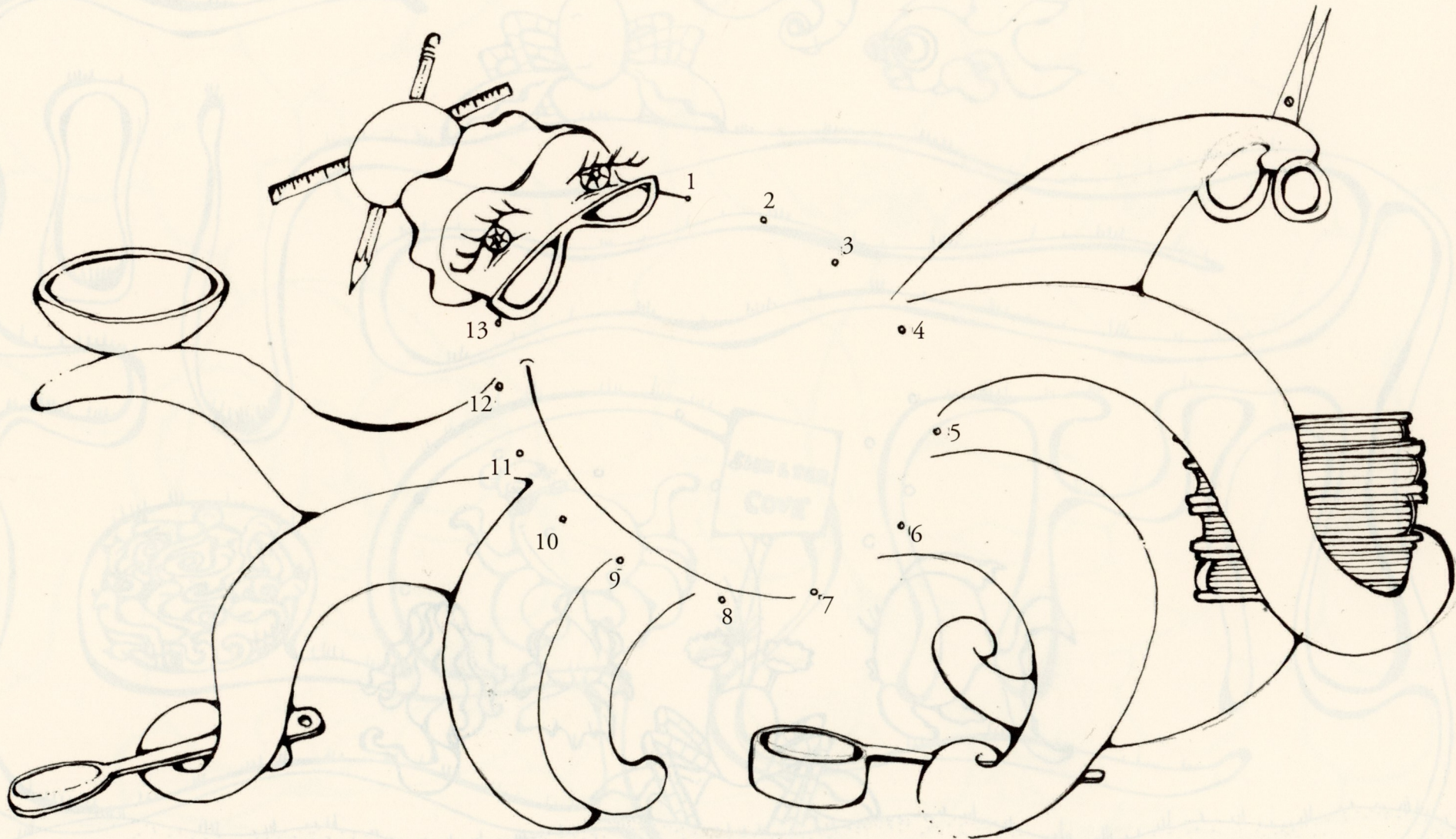
When Penelope, Herman, Pedro, and Serena lost their homes they felt sad and scared.

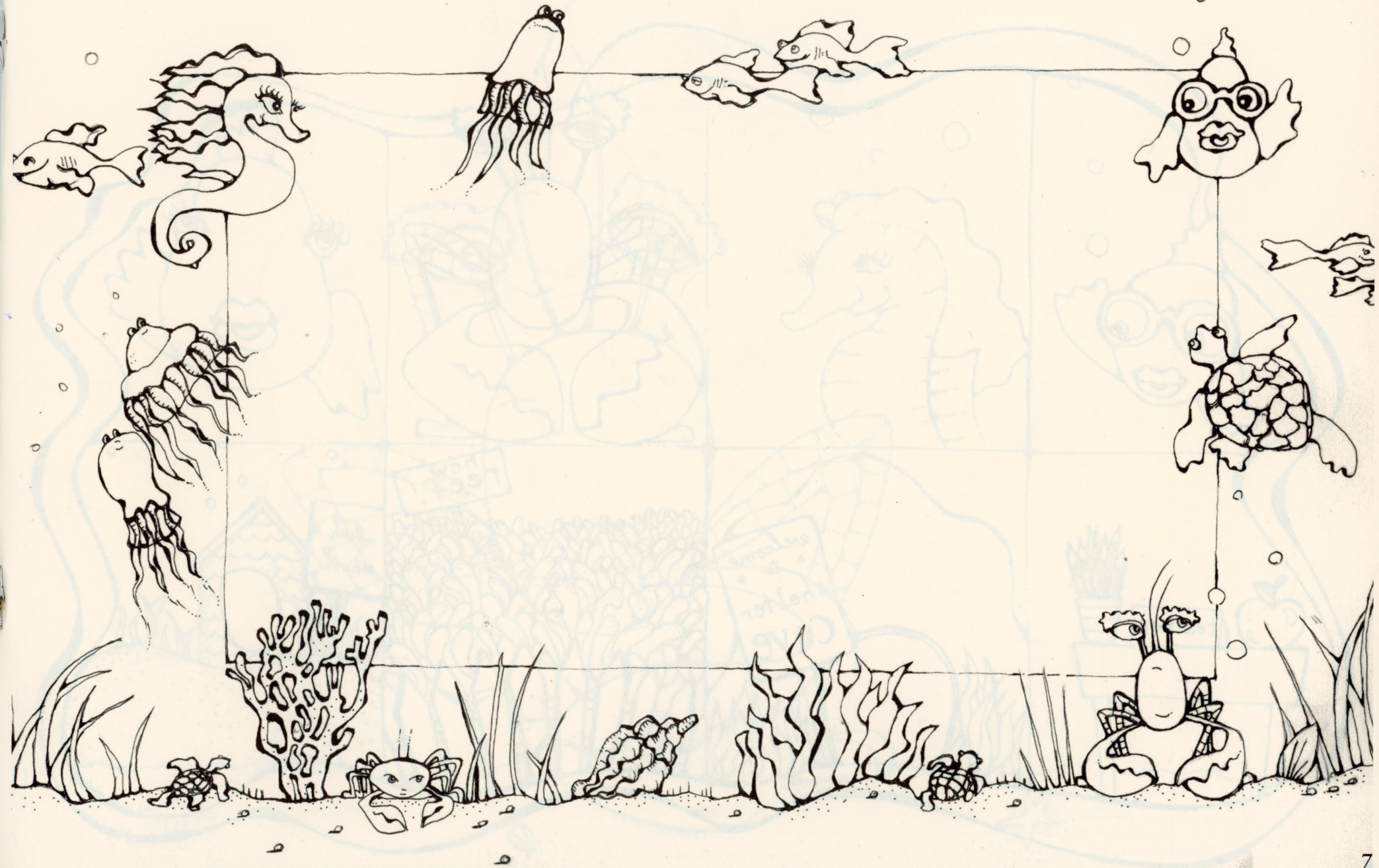
Help Henry and Auntie Oona meet Auntie Oona.

Pedro, Penelope, Herman, and Serena meet a variety of sea creatures at Shelter Cove.

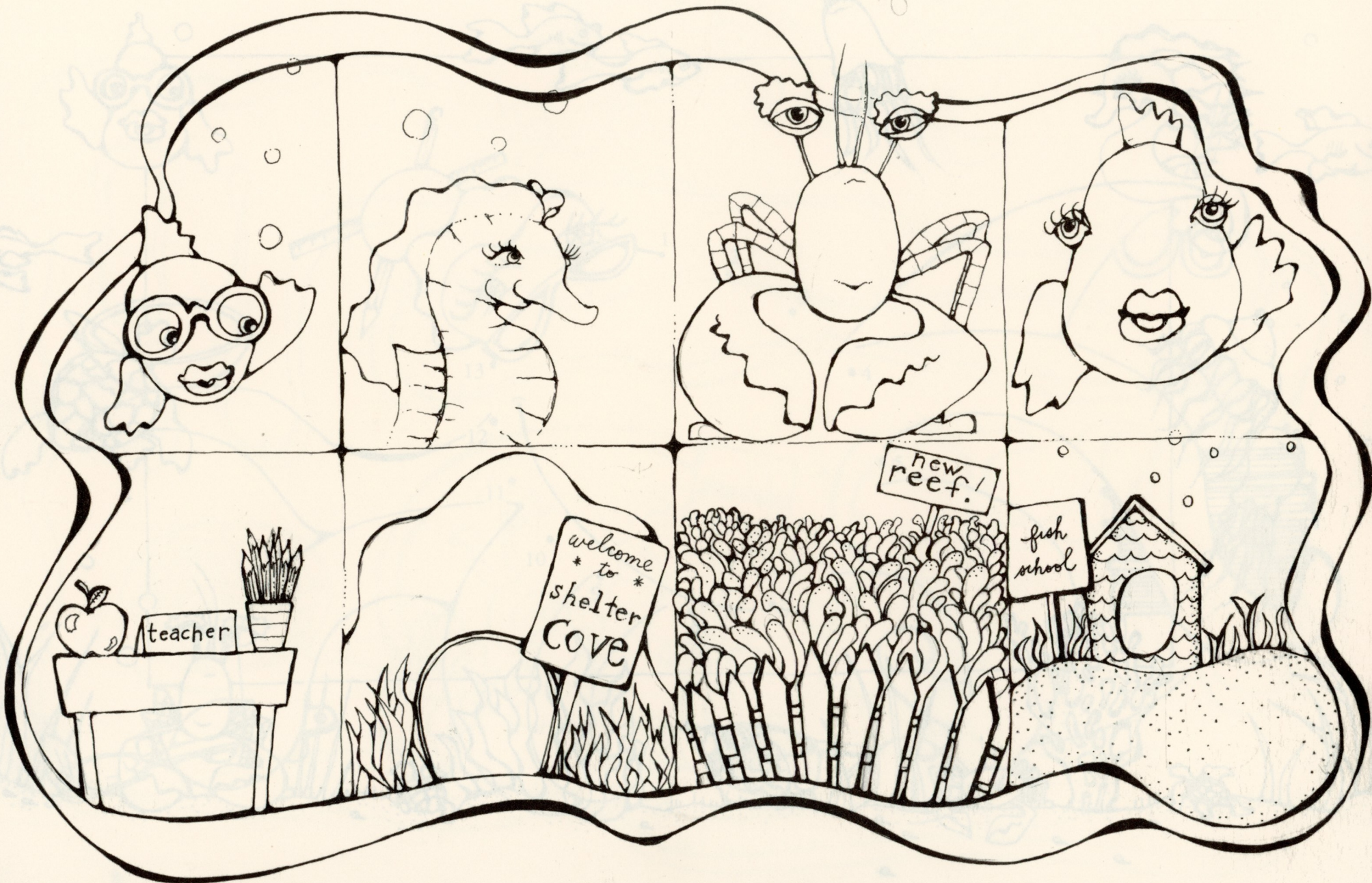
If you could be any sea creature what would you be and why?

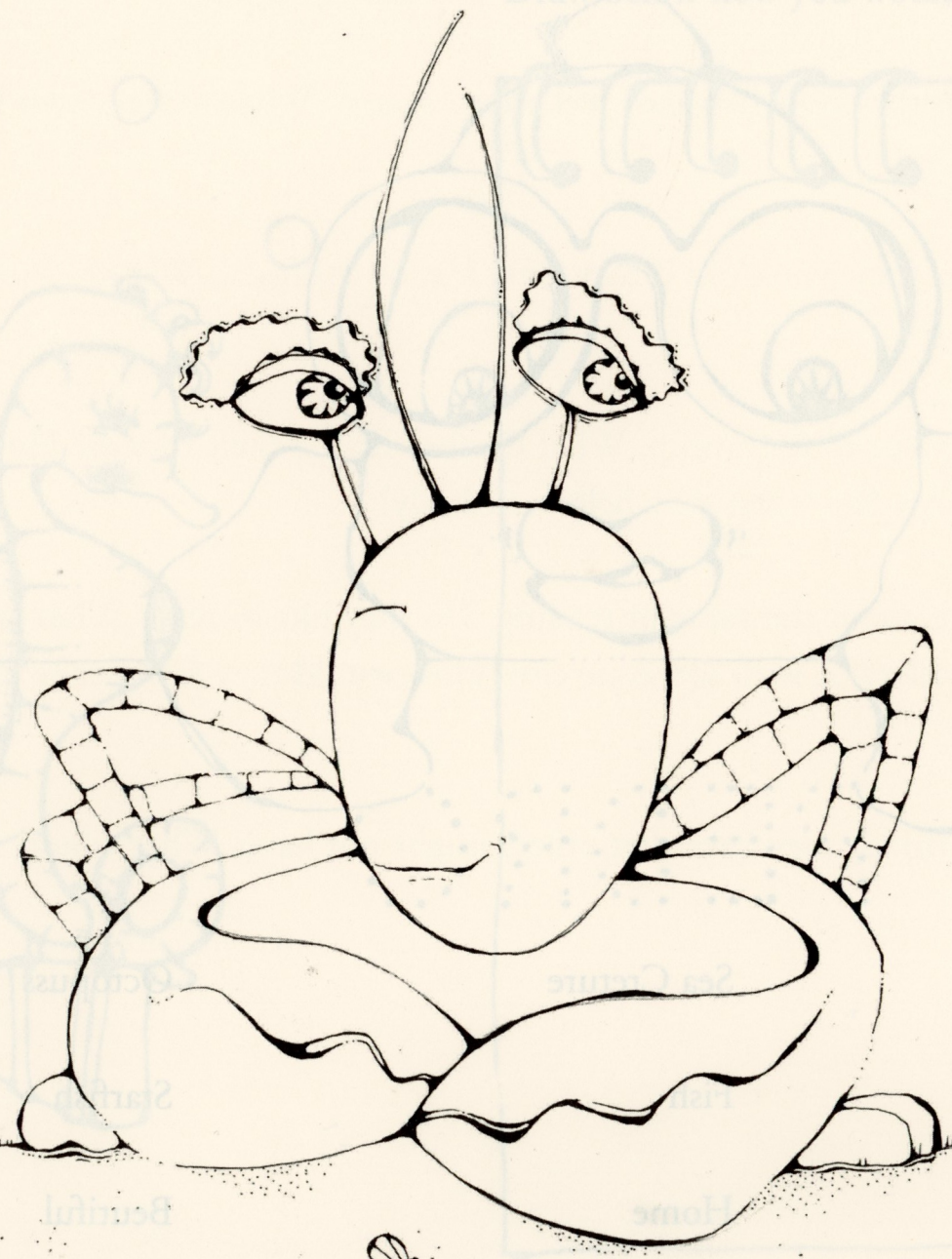

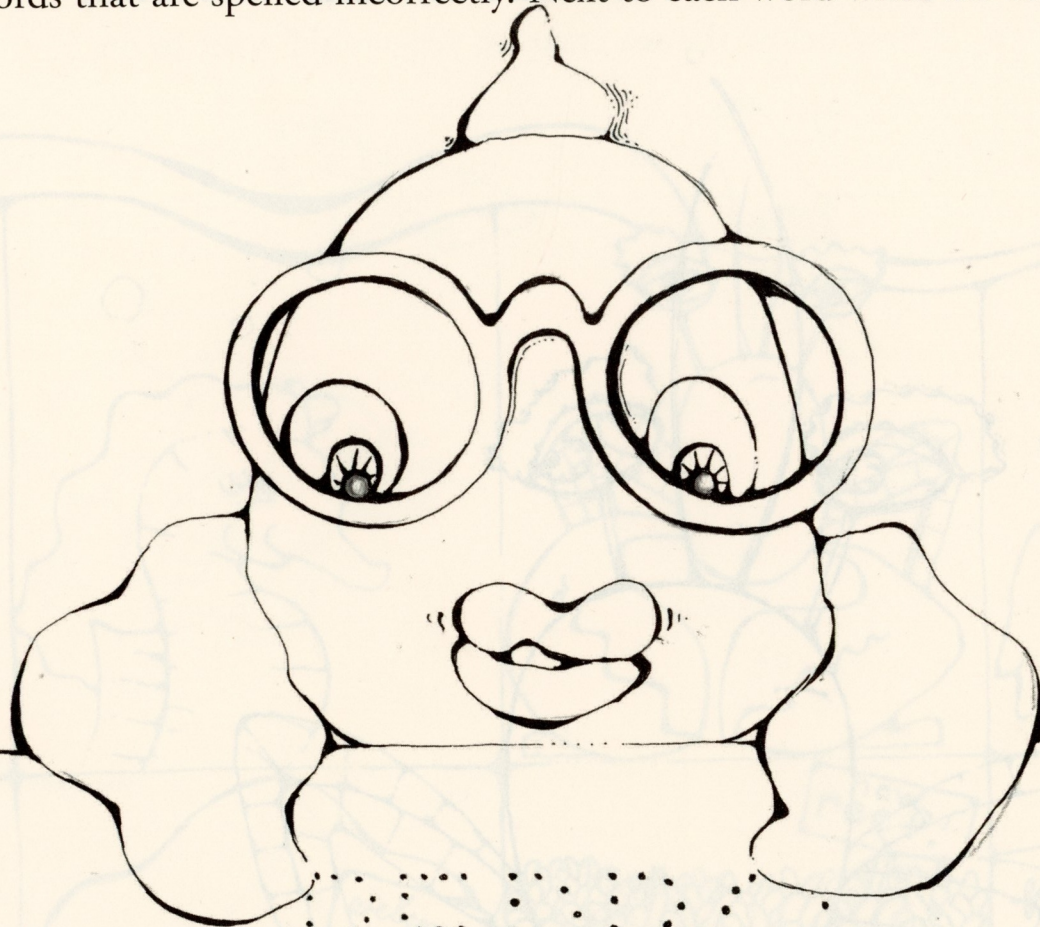

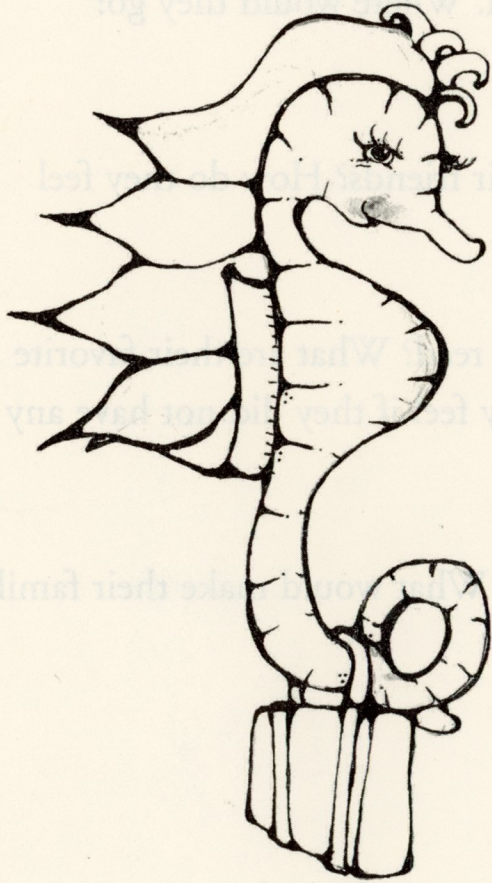

Tips for Parents and Teachers

The following suggestions are intended to enhance children's use of the activity book:

Encourage children to think about what they do when they feel sad or scared. What makes them feel better? Who comforts them?

Encourage children to think about what they would do if they were lost or confused. Where would they go? Who would they talk to?

Encourage children to think about the value of friendship. What do they do for their friends? How do they feel when somebody helps them? How do they feel when they help somebody?

Encourage children to read and to think about the value of reading. Do they like to read? What are their favorite stories? Do they prefer to read by themselves or with someone else? How would they feel if they did not have any books? Why is reading important?

Encourage children to think about the things they have that others might not have. What would make their family really happy?

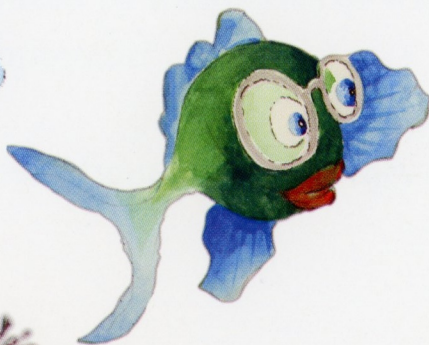
